#### **POSITION SUMMARY**

The Flinders Mates Facilitator engages Flinders University students from domestic and international backgrounds by facilitating discussion groups, with a partner, that build and encourage deeper cross-cultural connections and understanding, and reduce isolation within a fun, safe and informal environment.

Strong cross-cultural skills and the experience of working with people from different cultures are highly valuable skills and can provide students with a competitive edge in a global workforce. Facilitators commit to leading a group for one hour on Wednesdays and/ or Thursdays between 12 pm and 1 pm over each semester.

Flinders Mates Facilitation is an unpaid, voluntary role.

## **KEY RESPONSIBILITIES & OBJECTIVES**

- Provide an up to date Working With Children Check
- Participate in an introduction/training session (2-4 hours)
- Co-facilitate one or two, 1 hour session(s) per week during semesters 1 and 2
- Encourage equal participation from all group members
- Understand that the role of the Facilitator is to engage the participants in discussion, encouraging their input and limiting your own
- Encourage an environment of safety and mutual respect
- Provide honest and timely feedback to Oasis staff regarding any issues arising around the program or your volunteering
- Set and maintain clear boundaries around your role as Facilitator and refer any student welfare matters to Oasis staff

- 5. Have strong verbal communication skills
- 6. Have an ability to commit to the time involved over a 12-month period
- 7. Are willing to commit to regular communication with Oasis staff and other facilitators regarding this role

- 1. Experience living, working or studying with respect to a foreign culture
- 2. Leadership experience
